**TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT**

**The Employment and Training Act 1973  
(Commencement No. 4) Order 1975**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 15(2) of the Employment and Training Act 1973(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

*Citation and interpretation*

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Employment and Training Act 1973 (Commencement No. 4) Order 1975.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

*Appointed day*

2. The provisions mentioned in the first column of the Schedule to this Order (which relate to the matters specified in the second column of that Schedule) shall come into operation on 16th May 1975.
