## REGISTERS AND RECORDS, SCOTLAND

## Act of Sederunt (Amendment of Fees in the Scottish Record Office) 1975

Made - - - - - 6th May 1975

Coming into Operation 7th May 1975

The Lords of Council and Session, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section 10 of the Public Records (Scotland) Act 1937(a), as amended by section 1(7) of the Public Registers and Records Act (Scotland) 1948(b), and of all other powers competent to them in that behalf, and with the approval of the Treasury, do hereby enact as follows:—

1. The fees to be charged in the Scottish Record Office for inspection of records, for copies thereof, and for other services relating thereto shall be those set out in the Schedule to this Act of Sederunt.

2. Sections 2 and 3 of the Act of Sederunt (Amendment of Fees in the Scottish Record Office) 1974(c) are hereby repealed.

3. This Act of Sederunt may be cited as the Act of Sederunt (Amendment of Fees in the Scottish Record Office) 1975 and shall come into operation on the 7th day of May 1975.

And the Lords appoint this Act of Sederunt to be inserted in the Books of Sederunt.

The Keeper has discretion to reduce or waive the charge in appropriate cases and reserves the right to decline searches.

## 2. Handling Charge:

Per volume or document, in addition to reprographic charge ... .. 60p

*Note:* The handling charge is remitted or reduced for orders, by Xerography or similar methods, placed personally in the Search Rooms with the documents to be copied clearly identified, and where an inspection fee has already been incurred or remitted. The handling charge may also be remitted or reduced at the discretion of the Keeper of the Records of Scotland for approved educational or historical purposes. Additions may be made for difficult work or orders requiring special attention.

## 3. Authentication:

For each Extract or Certified Copy, in addition to reprographic charge and handling charge ... .. 45p

*Note:* No authentication is given for microfilms or for search room copies.

## 4. Postage and Packing:

Per order ... .. In accordance with current cost of postage and with a charge for packing.

## IV. OTHER SERVICES

1. For a record retransmitted or transmitted to any court, or exhibited therein, at the instance of a party, in accordance with the Rules of Court governing such transmissions or exhibitions... .. £1.50

2. For attendance by an officer of the Scottish Record Office at any court to produce a record in evidence for each day or part of a day, in addition to travelling expenses ... .. £20.00

*Note:* A sum not exceeding £20 a day may be applied at the discretion of the Keeper of the Records of Scotland where an officer of the Scottish Record Office attends with records for any purpose approved by the Keeper

3. For each Certificate issued under the Judgments Extension Act 1868 (31 & 32 Vict. c.54) ... .. £1.25

4. For each Certificate of Custody that a deed is retained for permanent preservation ... .. £1.25
