IMMIGRATION

**The Immigration (Registration with Police) (Amendment)
Regulations 1975**

Made - - - - 14th June 1975
Laid before Parliament 24th June 1975
Coming into Operation 1st September 1975

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 4(3) of the Immigration Act 1971(a), I hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Registration with Police) (Amendment) Regulations 1975 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1975.

2. In Regulation 10 of the Immigration (Registration with Police) Regulations 1972(b), for paragraph (3) there shall be substituted the following paragraph:—

“(3) An alien who is not a national of a state which is a member of the European Economic Community shall pay to the registration officer concerned the appropriate fee specified in the following Table:—

For a certificate issued on registration otherwise than as mentioned below... ..	£2.50
For a certificate issued on registration in respect of a wife or a child under 18 years at the time of registration, where a family is registered together	£0.50
For a certificate issued in replacement of one issued previously... ..	£1.00”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations replace paragraph (3) of Regulation 10 of the Immigration (Registration with Police) Regulations 1972 which provides for the payment of registration fees where aliens are required to register with the police. The fees payable are increased, except in the case of EEC nationals who will no longer be required to pay registration fees.
