ROAD TRAFFIC

The Motor Cars (Driving Instruction) (Amendment) Regulations 1976

Made - - - - 8th July 1976
Laid before Parliament 9th July 1976
Coming into Operation 1st August 1976

The Secretary of State for the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 128, 129, 131, 133 and 142 of the Road Traffic Act 1972(a), and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1st August 1976 and may be cited as the Motor Cars (Driving Instruction) (Amendment) Regulations 1976.
- 2.—(1) The Motor Cars (Driving Instruction) Regulations 1969(b), as amended(c), shall be further amended so as to have effect as if Regulation 9 (Ineligibility for submission to either part of examination within three months after failure) were deleted, and in Regulation 11 (Fees)—
 - (a) in paragraph (1) for the words "five pounds" there were substituted the words "£15";
 - (b) in paragraph (2) for the words "ten pounds" there were substituted the words "£25";
 - (c) in paragraph (3) for the words "fifteen pounds" there were substituted the words "£25";
 - (d) in paragraph (4) for the words "one pound" there were substituted the words "£15"; and
 - (e) in paragraph (5) for the words "fifteen pounds" there were substituted the words "£25".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Motor Cars (Driving Instruction) Regulations 1969, as amended, so as to—

- (1) delete Regulation 9 (Ineligibility for submission to either part of examination of ability to give instruction within three months of failure), and
- (2) increase the fee for-
 - (a) the written part of the examination of ability to give instruction from £5 to £15;
 - (b) the practical part of the examination of ability to give instruction from £10 to £25;
 - (c) an application for retention on the Register from £15 to £25;
 - (d) an application for a licence to give instruction from £1 to £15;
 - (e) an application for entry in the Register in the circumstances described in Regulation 11(5) of the Regulations of 1969 from £15 to £25.
