BURIAL, ENGLAND AND WALES**The Human Remains Removal Licence
(Variation of Maximum Fee) Order 1976**

Made - - - - - *2nd February 1976*
Laid before Parliament *10th February 1976*
Coming into Operation *20th February 1976*

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 5 of and Schedule 3 to the Public Expenditure and Receipts Act 1968(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Human Remains Removal Licence (Variation of Maximum Fee) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 20th February 1976.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) applies for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Section 7(1) of the Fees (Increase) Act 1923(c) (which relates to fees for licences to remove bodies after burial) shall be amended by substituting the words “four pounds” for the words “two pounds”.

 EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends section 7(1) of the Fees (Increase) Act 1923 to increase from £2 to £4 the maximum amount which may be prescribed by the Secretary of State, with the consent of the Treasury, for a fee in respect of a licence issued under section 25 of the Burial Act 1857¹(c.81); for the removal of human remains interred in a place of burial.
