The Residential Special Schools and Orphanages (Scotland) **Grant Amendment Regulations 1976**

1st September 1976 Made -10th September 1976 Laid before Parliament Coming into Operation 1st October 1976

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 75 of the Education (Scotland) Act 1962(a), as substituted by section 12 of the Education (Scotland) Act 1969(b) and by section 144(5) of the Education (Scotland) Act 1962, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:-

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Residential Special Schools and Orphanages (Scotland) Grant Amendment Regulations 1976 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1976.
- 2. The Residential Special Schools and Orphanages (Scotland) Grant Regulations 1948(c), as amended(d), shall be further amended by deleting in Regulation 1(1)(i) the words "which is attended largely by pupils whose parents or guardians are resident outwith the education area in which the school is situated.".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the provisions of Regulation 1(1)(i) of the Residential Special Schools and Orphanages (Scotland) Grant Regulations 1948 by removing the condition that to be eligible for grant from the Secretary of State a residential special school must be attended largely by pupils whose parents or guardians are resident outwith the education area in which the school is situated.
