The Bread Prices (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1976

Made	6th October 1976
Laid before Parliament	7th October 1976
Coming into Operation	11th October 1976

The Secretary of State, after consulting in accordance with subsection (6) of section 2 of the Prices Act 1974(a) as amended(b) with the organisations therein referred to, in exercise of his powers under subsections (1) and (8) of that section and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Bread Prices (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 11th October 1976.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if this Order and the Order hereby varied were Acts of Parliament.
- 2. Article 4 of the Bread Prices Order 1976(d) as varied(e) is hereby further varied by the substitution for the Table set out in paragraph (1) of that article of the following Table:-
