The Yorkshire Water Authority (Elmswell Wold **Borehole) Order 1976**

Made -

29th November 1976

Coming into Operation

13th December 1976

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Yorkshire Water Authority Citation and (Elmswell Wold Borehole) Order 1976 and shall come into operation commenceon 13th December 1976.

- (2) This order shall be included among the enactments which may be cited together as the Yorkshire Water Authority Orders 1974 to 1976.
 - 2. In this order, unless the context otherwise requires—

"the Authority" means the Yorkshire Water Authority;

Interpretation.

"the deposited plan" means the plan prepared in duplicate, signed by an Under Secretary in the Department of the Environment and marked "Plan referred to in the Yorkshire Water Authority (Elmswell Wold Borehole) Order 1976", one duplicate of which is deposited and available for inspection at the offices of the Solicitor of the Authority at West Riding House, 67 Albion Street, Leeds and the other at the offices of the Secretary of State for the Environment;

"the Third Schedule" means the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945:

"the undertaking" means the undertaking of the Authority as for the time being authorised by any enactment.

3. For the purposes of this order, the provisions of the Third Schedule Application which are specified in column (1) of Schedule 1 to this order, shall, subject of Third to the modifications set out in column (2) of the said Schedule 1, apply to the undertaking and are hereby incorporated with this order.

Schedule.

4. The Authority may, when they have acquired the necessary land or Power to sufficient rights therein, construct and maintain on and under the land construct described in Schedule 2 to this order a borehole and a switchgear and works. chlorinator house together with (in addition to the works authorised by section 4 of the Third Schedule as applied to the undertaking by this order) all such pumping stations, wells, boreholes, adits and headings as may be necessary or expedient for augmenting or improving the supply of water obtainable by means of the said borehole.

5. The borehole and any other works constructed in pursuance of this Works to order shall for all purposes be deemed to form part of the undertaking.
