## The Milk (Great Britain) (Amendment) (No. 3) Order 1976

*Made* - - - 2nd December 1976

*Laid before Parliament* 10th December 1976

*Coming into Operation* 2nd January 1977

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State, acting jointly in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 6 and 7 of the Emergency Laws (Re-enactments and Repeals) Act 1964(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This order may be cited as the Milk (Great Britain) (Amendment) (No. 3) Order 1976, and shall come into operation on 2nd January 1977.

*Amendment of the principal order*

2. The Milk (Great Britain) Order 1971(b) as amended(c) shall be further amended by substituting for Schedules 1 and 2 thereto respectively Schedules 1 and 2 to this order.

*Revocation*

3. The Milk (Great Britain) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1976(d) is hereby revoked.

## SCHEDULE 1

## MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES OF MILK IN ENGLAND AND WALES

1. Subject to the provision of this Schedule, the maximum price of milk on a sale by retail in England and Wales shall be a price in accordance with the following table:—

Milk	Maximum Price (Rate per Pint)
Channel Islands milk.....	p 12
South Devon milk.....	12
Untreated Milk Farm Bottled.....	11½
Ultra Heat Treated milk.....	11
Sterilised milk.....	11
Homogenised milk.....	11
Untreated milk.....	10½
Pasteurised milk.....	10½
Milk, other than the above mentioned.....	10½

2. A reasonable charge may be made by the seller in addition to the appropriate maximum price specified in the above table for milk sold by him as Kosher milk or Kedassia milk if—

- (a) such milk is sold in a container distinctly labelled “Kosher” or “Kedassia”, as the case may be; and
- (b) such milk has been prepared for consumption in accordance with the appropriate Jewish practice relating thereto.

## SCHEDULE 2

## MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICES OF MILK IN SCOTLAND

1. Subject to the provisions of this Schedule, the maximum price of milk on a sale by retail in Scotland, excluding the islands other than the islands of Arran, Bute, Coll, Gigha, Islay and The Great Cumbrae and those comprising the Islands Area of Orkney, shall be a price in accordance with the following table:—

Milk	Maximum Price (Rate per Pint)
Channel Islands milk.....	p 12
South Devon milk.....	12
Premium milk.....	11½
Ultra Heat Treated milk.....	11
Sterilised milk.....	11
Homogenised milk.....	11
Standard milk.....	10½
Pasteurised milk.....	10½
Milk, other than the above mentioned.....	10½

2. A reasonable charge may be made by the seller in addition to the appropriate maximum price specified in the above table for milk sold by him as Kosher milk or Kedassia milk if—

- (a) such milk is sold in a container distinctly labelled “Kosher” or “Kedassia”, as the case may be; and
- (b) such milk has been prepared for consumption in accordance with the appropriate Jewish practice relating thereto.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This amending Order, which comes into operation on 2nd January 1977, increases by 1p per pint the maximum retail prices of milk on sales in Great Britain.
