**The Industrial Training (Transfer of the  
Activities of Establishments) (No. 3) Order 1976**

*Made - - - - 8th December 1976*

*Coming into Operation*

*for all purposes of Article 3 17th January 1977*

*for all other purposes 1st April 1977*

The Secretary of State, on the recommendation of the Manpower Services Commission, and in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 9A(2) of the Industrial Training Act 1964, as inserted by section 6 of, and paragraph 13 of Part I of Schedule 2 to, the Employment and Training Act 1973, hereby makes the following Order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Industrial Training (Transfer of the Activities of Establishments) (No. 3) Order 1976.

(2) The provisions of this Order shall come into operation:—

- (a) for all purposes of Article 3 on 17th January 1977;
- (b) for all other purposes on 1st April 1977.

*Interpretation*

2.—(1) In this Order unless the context otherwise requires “the Act” means the Industrial Training Act 1964, as amended by the Employment and Training Act 1973.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

*Transfer of Establishments' Activities*

3. The activities carried on at each establishment specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order, being an establishment of an employer in the industry of an industrial training board, shall, instead of being included for the purposes of the Act in the industry of the industrial training board
