The Merchant Shipping (Oil Pollution) (Falkland Islands) (Amendment) Order 1976

Made - - - 15th December 1976

Laid before Parliament 23rd December 1976

Coming into Operation 13th January 1977

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 15th day of December 1976

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 18(1) of the Merchant Shipping (Oil Pollution) Act 1971(a), by section 20(1) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1974(b) and all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Oil Pollution) (Falkland Islands) (Amendment) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 13th January 1977.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply, with the necessary adaptations, for the purposes of interpreting this Order and otherwise in relation thereto as it applies for the purpose of interpreting, and in relation to, Acts of Parliament.
- 3. The provisions of the Merchant Shipping (Oil Pollution) Act 1971, as extended to the Falkland Islands by the Merchant Shipping (Oil Pollution) (Falkland Islands) Order 1975(d), listed in column 1 of Schedule 1 hereto shall be amended in accordance with the amendments set out in column 2 of the said Schedule.
- 4. The provisions of the Merchant Shipping Act 1974, as extended to the Falkland Islands by the Merchant Shipping (Oil Pollution) (Falkland Islands) Order 1975, listed in column 1 of Schedule 2 hereto shall be amended in accordance with the amendments set out in column 2 of the said Schedule.
