The Carriage by Air (Parties to Convention) (Supplementary)**Order 1976**

Made - - - - 19th January 1976

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 19th day of January 1976

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 2(1) of the Carriage by Air Act 1961(a) (which provides that Her Majesty may by Order in Council from time to time certify who are the High Contracting Parties to the Warsaw Convention as amended at the Hague, 1955, relating to international carriage by air, in respect of what territories they are respectively parties and to what extent they have availed themselves of the provisions of the Additional Protocol to the said Convention) and by that section as applied to international carriage under the unamended Warsaw Convention by Article 5 of the Carriage by Air Acts (Application of Provisions) Order 1967(b), and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1.—(1) It is hereby certified that the High Contracting Parties to the Warsaw Convention and to the Warsaw Convention as amended at The Hague, 1955, and the territories in respect of which they are respectively parties are, in addition to those certified in Schedule 1 to the Carriage by Air (Parties to Convention) Order 1975(c), as specified in the Schedule to this Order.

(2) In the said Schedule an asterisk in a column opposite the name of a territory means that this Order does not certify that a state is a party, in respect of that territory, to the Convention named at the head of the column.

2. This Order may be cited as the Carriage by Air (Parties to Convention) (Supplementary) Order 1976.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

The Carriage by Air Act 1961 gives effect in the United Kingdom to the Warsaw Convention as amended at the Hague, 1955, relating to international carriage by air, and the Carriage by Air Acts (Application of Provisions) Order 1967 makes transitional provision for the application of that Act to carriage still governed by the unamended Warsaw Convention, to which the United Kingdom remains a party.

Under section 2(1) of the Act and Article 5 of that Order, Her Majesty may, by Order in Council, from time to time certify, inter alia, who are the High Contracting Parties to the Warsaw Convention as amended at the Hague and to the unamended Warsaw Convention, and such an Order is conclusive evidence of the matters so certified.

This Order, which is supplementary to the Carriage by Air (Parties to Convention) Order 1975, certifies additional High Contracting Parties to the Conventions and the territories in respect of which they are Parties.
