# The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Exhibition of Flying) Regulations 1976

Made - - - -

13th April 1976

Coming into Operation

3rd May 1976

Whereas the Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the areas specified in the Schedule hereto by reason of the intended holding of exhibitions of flying by the Red Arrows display team:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under Article 66 of the Air Navigation Order 1974(a), as amended (b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Exhibition of Flying) Regulations 1976 and shall come into operation on 3rd May 1976.
- 2.—(1) Expressions used in these Regulations shall, unless the context otherwise requires, have the same respective meanings as in the Air Navigation Order 1974, as amended.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the purpose of the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the purpose of the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3.—(1) This Regulation applies to each of the areas specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, being in each case an area bounded by a circle of four nautical miles radius centred on the position specified in column 2 of the said schedule opposite its name.
- (2) An aircraft shall not fly below a height of 5,500 feet above ground level over an area to which this Regulation applies during such period of the day specified in column 3 of the Schedule hereto in relation to that area as may be notified for the purpose of this Regulation.
