## CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

**The Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duties Order 1973  
(Amendment) Order 1976**

<i>Made - - - - -</i>	13th May 1976
<i>Laid before the House of Commons</i>	20th May 1976
<i>Coming into Operation - - -</i>	10th June 1976

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by sections 1, 2 and 15(4) of the Customs Duties (Dumping and Subsidies) Act 1969(a), and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duties Order 1973 (Amendment) Order 1976 and shall come into operation on 10th June 1976.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duties Order 1973(d), as amended (e), shall be further amended by substituting for the entry in Schedule 1 in relation to tariff subheading 29.26 A.I. the following entry:—

“29.26 A.I. Saccharin and its salts originating in the Republic of Korea	£0.5511 per kilogramme”

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order removes the anti-dumping duty of £0.0917 per kilogramme chargeable by virtue of the Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duties Order 1973 on saccharin and its salts originating in Japan.
