REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE**The Elections (Welsh Forms) Regulations 1976**

Made - - - - - 30th November 1976
 Laid before Parliament 9th December 1976
 Coming into Operation 1st February 1977

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 42 and 171(5) of the Representation of the People Act 1949(a) and by section 2(2) of the Welsh Language Act 1967(b), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Elections (Welsh Forms) Regulations 1976 and shall come into operation, subject to their having been approved by both Houses of Parliament, on 1st February 1977.

2. For Note 2 (in English and Welsh) to the Form set out in Part I of Schedule 1 to the Elections (Welsh Forms) Regulations 1975(c) (return by occupier as to residents) there shall be substituted the following Note:—

“2. Do not enter

- (a) Aliens;
- (b) Members of H.M. Forces;
- (c) Wives or husbands of Members of H.M. Forces;
- (d) Crown servants employed outside the U.K.;
- (e) British Council staff employed outside the U.K.;
- (f) Wives or husbands of Crown servants or British Council staff employed outside the U.K. if living abroad to be with their husbands or wives.

Their names will be included in the register if they have made the necessary service declaration; to do this they should apply to their Service or Department or to the British Council.

2. Peidiwch â chynnwys

- (a) Tramorwyr;
- (b) Aelodau o Luoedd Ei Mawrhydi;
- (c) Gwŷr neu wragedd aelodau o Luoedd Ei Mawrhydi;
- (d) Gweision y Goron sy'n gwasanaethu y tu allan i'r Deyrnas Gyfunol;
- (e) Aelodau o staff y Cyngor Prydeinig sy'n gwasanaethu y tu allan i'r Deyrnas Gyfunol;
- (f) Gwŷr neu wragedd gweision y Goron neu staff y Cyngor Prydeinig sy'n gwasanaethu y tu allan i'r Deyrnas Gyfunol os ydynt yn byw mewn gwlad dramor er mwyn bod gyda'u gwŷr neu'u gwragedd.

Rhoddir eu henwau ar y gofrestr wedi iddynt wneud y datganiad gwasanaeth angenrheidiol; i wneud hyn, dylent anfon cais at eu Gwasanaeth neu eu Hadran neu at y Cyngor Prydeinig.”

3. The Notes (in English and Welsh) to the Form—headed “HOW TO RETURN THE FORM—SUT I DDYCHWELYD Y FFURFLEN”—set out in Part I of Schedule 1 to the Elections (Welsh Forms) Regulations 1975 (return by occupier as to residents) shall be omitted.

These Regulations amend Note 2 to the bilingual Form A, Return by Occupier as to Residents, prescribed in the Elections (Welsh Forms) Regulations 1975. The amendments are in consequence of the coming into operation of the Representation of the People (Armed Forces) Act 1976 (c. 29).
