CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

The Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duties (No. 2)
Order 1977

<i>Made - - - -</i>	<i>27th June 1977</i>
<i>Laid before the House of Commons</i>	<i>28th June 1977</i>
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	<i>30th June 1977</i>

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by sections 1, 2, 7 and 15(4) of the Customs Duties (Dumping and Subsidies) Act 1969(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duties (No. 2) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 30th June 1977.
2. The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. In any Order made under the Customs Duties (Dumping and Subsidies) Act 1969 and in force on 30th June 1977 (including any Order where the duty is suspended) for “Customs Tariff 1959” there shall be substituted “common customs tariff of the European Economic Community”.
4. The following Orders, namely the Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duties Order 1973(d), as amended(e), the Anti-Dumping Duty Order 1975(f), the Countervailing Duty Order 1976(g) and the Anti-Dumping Duty (No. 3) Order 1976(h) shall be amended as specified in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

Amendments to the Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duties Order 1973, the Anti-Dumping Duty Order 1975, the Countervailing Duty Order 1976 and the Anti-Dumping Duty (No. 3) Order 1976.

1. For the entries in columns 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to the Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duties Order 1973 relating to headings 73.01 and 77.01 there shall be substituted the following entries:—

<i>Tariff Heading</i>	<i>Description</i>
73.01 B.	Haematite pig iron and cast iron (ECSC) originating in the German Democratic Republic and Berlin (East), excluding (1) pig iron smelted wholly with charcoal and (2) pig iron produced in an electric furnace and containing, by weight, not more than 0.025% of phosphorus, not more than 0.02% of sulphur and not more than 2.5% of total carbon.
73.01 C.	Phosphoric pig iron and cast iron (ECSC) originating in the German Democratic Republic and Berlin (East), excluding pig iron smelted wholly with charcoal.
73.01 D.I.	Other pig iron and cast iron containing, by weight, not less than 0.30% but not more than 1% of titanium and not less than 0.50% but not more than 1% of vanadium (ECSC) originating in the German Democratic Republic and Berlin (East), excluding vanadium-titanium pig iron produced in an electric furnace.
73.01 D.II.	Other pig iron and cast iron (ECSC) originating in the German Democratic Republic and Berlin (East), excluding <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Pig iron, smelted wholly with charcoal (b) Vanadium-titanium pig iron produced in an electric furnace (c) Pig iron produced in an electric furnace and containing, by weight, more than 0.1% of cobalt but not more than 0.025% of phosphorus and not more than 0.02% of sulphur (d) Pig iron produced in an electric furnace and containing, by weight, not more than 0.025% of phosphorus, not more than 0.02% of sulphur and not more than 2.5% of total carbon.
77.01 A.	Unwrought magnesium originating in the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics excluding alloys of magnesium.

(2) For the entry in column 1 of the Schedule to the Anti-Dumping Duty Order 1975 there shall be substituted "ex 44.23 B".

(3) For the entries in column 1 of the Schedule to the Countervailing Duty Order 1976 there shall be substituted "ex 64.02 A"

(4) For the entries in column 1 of the Schedule to the Anti-Dumping Duty (No. 3) Order 1976 there shall be substituted "ex 91.02 B" and "ex 91.04 B".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order makes the necessary consequential amendments to tariff headings and descriptions of goods in Orders made under the Customs Duties (Dumping and Subsidies) Act 1969 (including one case where the duty is suspended until 23rd November 1977) for the application of the common customs tariff of the European Economic Community and the ECSC unified tariff by the United Kingdom. The United Kingdom has to apply these tariffs in respect of the goods in question in full from 1st July 1977 under Article 39 of the Act annexed to the Treaty of Accession to the European Economic Community.
