The Magistrates' Courts (Forms) (Amendment) Rules 1977

The Lord Chancellor in exercise of the power conferred on him by section 15 of the Justices of the Peace Act 1949(a), as extended by section 122 of the Magistrates' Courts Act 1952(b), after consultation with the Rule Committee under the said section 15, hereby makes the following Rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Magistrates' Courts (Forms) (Amendment) Rules 1977 and shall come into operation on 5th September 1977.

2. In the Schedule to the Magistrates' Courts (Forms) Rules 1968(c), as amended(d), after Form 49 there shall be inserted the form contained in the Schedule to these Rules.

These Rules prescribe the form of notice of registration to be given to a person against whom a financial penalty enforcement order has been made under the Army Act 1955 (c.18), the Air Force Act 1955 (c.19) or the Naval Discipline Act 1957 (c.53) when the order has been registered in a magistrates' court in accordance with provisions of those Acts as amended by section 16, of and Schedule 8 to, the Armed Forces Act 1976. (c.52).
