# The Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland) Order 1977

Made - - - - Coming into Operation

25th January 1977 2nd February 1977

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2(1) as read with section 11 of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf and having been satisfied as respects the area hereinafter mentioned that certain waters therein are infected waters, hereby makes the following order:—

#### Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 2nd February 1977.

# Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

# Infected Area

3. The area comprising Torhouse Mill Fishery, Wigtown, including the Hatchery situated thereon bordered on the north by the B733 Wigtown/Kirkcowan road, on the east by the west bank of the outflow stream from Loch Gib, on the south by the north bank of the River Bladnoch, on the west by a straight line drawn from the junction of the westmost of the two slip roads leading to Torhouse Mill Fishery from the said B733 with the drive leading to the said Fishery, to that point on the north bank of the River Bladnoch to which Ordnance Survey grid reference NX 395555 refers and on the north-west by the westmost of the two slip roads leading to Torhouse Mill from the said B733 is declared to be an infected area for the purpose of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937.

### Control of movement of fish, etc.

4. No person shall without the previous consent in writing of the Secretary of State move out of the area declared by Article 3 above to be an infected area any live fish, or eggs of fish or foodstuffs for fish.

# **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This Order declares Torhouse Mill Fishery, Wigtown to be an infected area for the purposes of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937 and prohibits the movement out of the area of any live fish, eggs of fish, or foodstuff for fish.
