**MERCHANT SHIPPING**
**The Merchant Shipping Act 1974 (Jersey) (Amendment)  
Order 1977**

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 20(1) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1974(a) and section 738(1) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1894(b) (read with section 23(1) of the said Act of 1974) is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Merchant Shipping Act 1974 (Jersey) (Amendment) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1977.

2. In the Schedule to the Merchant Shipping Act 1974 (Jersey) Order 1975(c) for paragraph 5 there shall be substituted the following provision:—

“5. In section 2(9) for the definitions of “company” and “group” there shall be substituted the following definitions—

‘ “company” means a company registered in pursuance of the Companies (Jersey) Laws 1861 to 1968 or a body incorporated under the law of the United Kingdom or of any other country;

“group” in relation to companies, means a holding company and its subsidiaries as defined by section 154 of the Companies Act 1948, an Act of Parliament (or for companies in Northern Ireland section 148 of the Companies Act (Northern Ireland) 1960, an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland), subject, in the case of a company incorporated in Jersey or elsewhere outside the United Kingdom, to any necessary modifications of those definitions;’”

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order amends the Merchant Shipping Act 1974 (Jersey) Order 1975 which extended certain provisions of the Merchant Shipping Act 1974 to the Bailiwick of Jersey with exceptions, adaptations and modifications specified in the Schedule to that Order.

It substitutes for paragraph 5 of the Schedule to the Order of 1975 a new paragraph which redefines two expressions. "Company" is redefined to include a body incorporated otherwise than under the law of Jersey whether under the law of the United Kingdom or of any other country. "Group" in relation to companies is redefined in terms which reflect the new definition of "company".
