**The Education Authority Bursaries (Scotland)
Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1977**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by sections 49(3) and 144(5) of the Education (Scotland) Act 1962(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations, which may be cited as the Education Authority Bursaries (Scotland) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1977, shall come into operation on 9th August 1977.

Amendment of regulations

2. In the Education Authority Bursaries (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1977(b), for sub-paragraph (iv) of Regulation 3(c) the following sub-paragraph is hereby substituted—

“(iv) for sub-paragraph 1(8) there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraph—

‘An allowance of £6 a week towards the personal expenses of the holder, after he has attained the age of 18 years, during periods other than vacations.’ ”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations make an amendment to Schedule 2 part 1 paragraph 1(8) of the Education Authority Bursaries (Scotland) Regulations 1969 in substitution for the amendment of that sub-paragraph made in Regulation 3(c)(iv) of the Education Authority Bursaries (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1977. These Regulations make clear that an allowance towards personal expenses shall be payable only to the holder of a category B Bursary during term-time.
