PENSIONS

The Pensions Increase (Welsh Development Agency) Regulations 1977

Made - - - 20th January 1977

Laid before Parliament 10th February 1977

Coming into Operation 3rd March 1977

The Minister for the Civil Service, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 5(2) and (4) of the Pensions (Increase) Act 1971(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Pensions Increase (Welsh Development Agency) Regulations 1977, and shall come into operation on 3rd March 1977.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2. The Pensions (Increase) Act 1971 shall have effect in relation to a pension payable by virtue of paragraph 12 of Schedule 1 or of Regulations made or to be made under paragraph 3 of Schedule 2 of the Welsh Development Agency Act 1975(c) as if it were a pension specified in Part 1 of Schedule 2 to the Pensions (Increase) Act 1971.
- 3. Any increase of pension payable by virtue of these Regulations shall take effect in relation to a pension payable for any period beginning on or after 12th November 1975 as if these regulations had come into operation on that date.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations apply the provisions of the Pensions (Increase) Act 1971 to certain pensions paid by the Welsh Development Agency in accordance with the Welsh Development Agency Act 1975. Under the power conferred by section 5(4) of the Pensions (Increase) Act 1971, the regulations are retrospective to 12th November 1975.
