Made - - - - - *6th September 1977*

Coming into Operation *1st October 1977*

The Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 45 of the Bankruptcy (Scotland) Act 1913(a) as substituted by section 5 of the Insolvency Act 1976(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby makes the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Notice of Claim (Scotland) Regulations 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1977.

2. A Notice of Claim to be produced by a creditor in accordance with section 45 of the Bankruptcy (Scotland) Act 1913(a) shall be in the form set out in the Schedule hereto.
