**The Yorkshire Water Authority (River Esk,
Briggswath Intake) Order 1977**

Made - - - 14th September 1977

Coming into Operation 1st October 1977

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Yorkshire Water Authority (River Esk, Briggswath Intake) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1977.

Citation and commencement.

(2) This order shall be included among the enactments which may be cited together as the Yorkshire Water Authority Orders 1974 to 1977.

2. In this order, unless the context otherwise requires—

Interpretation.

“the Authority” means the Yorkshire Water Authority;

“the deposited plan” means the plan prepared in duplicate, signed by an Under Secretary in the Department of the Environment and marked “Plan referred to in the Yorkshire Water Authority (River Esk, Briggswath Intake) Order 1977”, one duplicate of which is deposited and available for inspection at the offices of the Solicitor to the Authority at West Riding House, 67 Albion Street, Leeds, and the other at the offices of the Secretary of State for the Environment;

“the Third Schedule” means the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945;

“the undertaking” means the water undertaking of the Authority as for the time being authorised by any enactment.

3. For the purposes of this order, the provisions of the Third Schedule which are specified in column (1) of Schedule 1 to this order shall, subject to the modifications set out in column (2) to the said Schedule 1, apply to the undertaking and are hereby incorporated with this order.

Application of Third Schedule.

4. The Authority may, when they have acquired the necessary land or sufficient rights therein, construct and maintain on and under the land described in Schedule 2 to this order an intake with a reinforced concrete chamber, bar screen and a submersible pump together with an access road.

Power to construct works.

5. The works authorised by this order shall for all purposes be deemed to form part of the undertaking.

PROVISIONS OF THE THIRD SCHEDULE APPLIED

Provisions Applied (1)	Modifications (2)
Section 4 (General power to construct subsidiary works)	The words "and to any other provisions of the special Act limiting the powers of the undertakers to abstract water" shall be omitted; and for the words "any land for the time being held by them in connection with their water undertaking" there shall be substituted the words "the land described in the special Act."
Section 92 (Liability of undertakers to pay compensation)	—
Section 94 (copies of the special Act to be kept by undertakers in their office, and deposited with certain officers)	—
