The North West Water Authority (Manchester) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1977

Made--16th September 1977Coming into Operation1st October 1977

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by the proviso to section 19(6) of the Water Act 1945 (a) and now vested in him (b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the North West Water Authority (Manchester) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1977.

2. The byelaws made on 16th October 1967 by the lord mayor, aldermen and citizens of the city of Manchester under section 17 of the Water Act 1945, which byelaws would, but for this order, cease to have effect on 15th October 1977, shall remain in force until 15th October 1978.
