## The East Surrey Water Company (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1977

Made ---27th September 1977Coming into Operation1st November 1977

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to section 19(6) of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:---

1. This order may be cited as the East Surrey Water Company (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1977.

2. The byelaws made on 13th November 1967 by the East Surrey Water Company under section 17 of the Water Act 1945, which byelaws would, but for this order, cease to have effect on 12th November 1977, shall remain in force until 12th November 1978.
