SHERIFF COURT, SCOTLAND

Act of Sederunt (Interim Orders for Aliment etc.) 1977

Made - - - - 21st October 1977

Coming into Operation 18th November 1977

The Lords of Council and Session under and by virtue of the powers conferred on them by section 32 of the Sheriff Courts (Scotland) Act 1971(a) and of all other powers competent to them in that behalf do hereby enact and declare:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Act of Sederunt may be cited as the Act of Sederunt (Interim Orders for Aliment etc.) 1977 and shall come into operation on 18th November 1977.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply to this Act of Sederunt as it applies to an Act of Parliament.

(3) In this Act of Sederunt “the Act” means the Sheriff Courts (Scotland) Act 1907(c), as amended.

Interim orders for aliment etc.

2. In Schedule 1 to the Act, rule 121, there shall be added at the end the following words:—

“The Court may make such interim orders in relation to the application as it thinks fit.”

And the Lords appoint this Act of Sederunt to be inserted in the Books of Sederunt.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Act of Sederunt amends Rule 171 in the Schedule to the Sheriff Courts (Scotland) Act 1907 by inserting a provision to enable interim orders to vary sheriff court decrees for aliment and for custody of or access to children to be made.
