The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by the proviso to section 19(6) of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

- 1. This order may be cited as the Severn-Trent Water Authority (North West Gloucestershire) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 7th February 1977.
- 2. The byelaws made on 13th February 1967 by the North West Gloucestershire Water Board under section 17 of the Water Act 1945, which byelaws would, but for this order, cease to have effect on 12th February 1977, shall remain in force until 12th February 1978.
