**The Tribunals and Inquiries (Supplementary Benefit Appeal
Tribunals) Order 1977**

The Lord Chancellor and the Lord Advocate, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 15(3) of the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1971 (a), as amended by the Transfer of Functions (Secretary of State and Lord Advocate) Order 1972 (b) hereby make the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Tribunals and Inquiries (Supplementary Benefit Appeal Tribunals) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1978.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889 (c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. Section 13 of the Tribunals and Inquiries Act 1971 shall apply to the appeal tribunals constituted in accordance with Schedule 4 to the Supplementary Benefits Act 1976 (d) in relation to proceedings brought before these tribunals after this Order comes into operation.
