# The Town and Country Planning (Repeal of Provisions No. 10) (Cleveland (Part)) Order 1977

The Secretary of State for the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 21(2) and 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971(a) hereby makes the following order:—

- 1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Town and Country Planning (Repeal of Provisions No. 10) (Cleveland (Part)) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 19th December 1977.
- (2) In this order "the Act" means the Town and Country Planning Act 1971; and "the Order area" means the area described in the Schedule to the order.
- 2. The provisions of the Act contained in Part I of Schedule 5 and in Schedule 6 to the Act are hereby repealed as respects the Order area.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order, which is made in consequence of the approval of the structure plans for that part of the County of Cleveland described in the Schedule to the order (formerly the county borough of Teesside and parts of the administrative counties of the North Riding of Yorkshire and of Durham), repeals for the areas covered by those structure plans the provisions of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 relating to development plans which are contained in Part I of Schedule 5 and in Schedule 6 to that Act. Those provisions which substantially re-enacted the provisions of the former Town and Country Planning Act 1962 (c. 38) relating to development plans are now superseded, in the area to which this order relates, by the provisions relating to structure and local plans contained in Part II of the Act of 1971.

Following this repeal, the development plans for the area to which this order relates are, by virtue of the provisions of paragraph 2 of Schedule 7 to the Act, the above mentioned structure plans read together with the development plans (within the meaning of Schedule 5) which are in force in that area at the date when this order comes into operation. The structure plans prevail in any case of conflict between the provisions of the structure plans and the old development plans.
