The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 17(1) of the Dock Work Regulation Act 1976(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into force on 1st December 1977 the provisions of the Dock Work Regulation Act 1976 which relate to the duty of the National Dock Labour Board to review work which is dock work for the purposes of the Dock Workers Employment Scheme 1967, and to report to the Secretary of State thereon with a view to its being classified as dock work for the purposes of the new Dock Labour Scheme. It also brings into force on the same date the provisions which enable the Secretary of State to make classification orders pursuant to such reports and which specify the effect of introducing the new Scheme.
