**The Wessex Water Authority (Sherborne Lake Discharge)
Order 1977**

Made - - - 10th November 1977

Coming into Operation 28th November 1977

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by section 1 of the Water Resources Act 1971(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Wessex Water Authority (Sherborne Lake Discharge) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 28th November 1977. Citation and commencement.

(2) This order shall be included among the enactments which may be cited together as the Wessex Water Authority Orders 1974 to 1977.

2. The Wessex Water Authority may for the purposes of augmenting the flow of water in the River Yeo discharge water from Sherborne Lake at National Grid Reference Point ST 647166 at a rate not exceeding 150,000 cubic metres per day of 24 hours commencing at midnight: Authority to discharge water.

Provided that the said Authority shall not by such discharge cause the level of water in the River Yeo as measured by a gauge at Bradford Abbas at National Grid Reference Point ST 589141 to exceed 1.50 metres above station datum.
