In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 54(4) of and paragraph 1 of Schedule 3 to the Powers of Criminal Courts Act 1973(a) (as extended by Article 3 of the Combined Probation and After-Care Areas Order 1974(b)) and after the consultation required by that paragraph, I hereby make the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Combined Probation and After-Care Areas (West Midlands) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st December 1977.
- 2. Schedule 2 to the Combined Probation and After-Care Areas Order 1974 shall be amended by substituting for the entry in respect of West Midlands the following entry:—
