The Bristol Waterworks Order 1977

Made - - - - 17th November 1977

Coming into Operation 5th December 1977

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by sections 32 and 50 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him (b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Bristol Waterworks Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 5th December 1977. Citation and commencement.

(2) The Bristol Waterworks Acts and Orders 1862 to 1974 and this order may be cited together as the Bristol Waterworks Acts and Orders 1862 to 1977.

2. Section 55 (making and dates for payment of water rates) of the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945 as applied to the undertaking of the Bristol Waterworks Company by section 4 of the Bristol Waterworks Order 1947(c) shall have effect as if at the end of subsection (1) thereof, for the proviso inserted by section 2 of the Bristol Waterworks (No. 2) Order 1967(d), there were substituted:— Power to make single quarterly rate.

“Provided that notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this subsection the undertakers may make a water rate by fixing a rate poundage in respect of the period of three months next following the expiration of any one such period of twelve months.”

For the purposes of this order, section 94 of the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945 (undertakers to keep a copy of the special Act at their principal office and to deposit copies with certain officers) shall apply to the undertaking of the Bristol Waterworks Company and is hereby incorporated with this order.
