Coming into Operation 30th November 1977

The Secretary of State for Wales, in exercise of powers conferred by the proviso to section 19(6) of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him (b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the Welsh National Water Development Authority (Mid-Glamorgan) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 30th November 1977.

2. The byelaws made on 2nd December 1963 by the Mid-Glamorgan Water Board under section 17 of the Water Act 1945, which byelaws would, by virtue of the Welsh National Water Development Authority (Mid-Glamorgan) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1976(c) remain in force until 1st December 1977, shall remain in force until 1st December 1978.
