The Yorkshire Water Authority (East Yorkshire–Wolds Area)

(Extension of Operation of Byelaws; No. 2) Order 1977

Made - - - - 29th November 1977

Coming into Operation 12th December 1977

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by the proviso to section 19(6) of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the Yorkshire Water Authority (East Yorkshire–Wolds Area) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws; No. 2) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 12th December 1977.

2. The byelaws made on 20th April 1977 by the East Yorkshire (Wolds Area) Water Board under section 17 of the Water Act 1945, which byelaws would, by virtue of the Yorkshire Water Authority (East Yorkshire–Wolds Area) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1977(c), remain in force until 31st December 1977, shall remain in force until 31st December 1978.
