# The M25 Motorway (Staines Interchange **Connecting Roads) Scheme 1977**

Made -

1st December 1977

Coming into Operation

8th December 1977

The Secretary of State for Transport makes this Scheme in exercise of powers conferred by sections 11, 12 and 14 of the Highways Act 1959(a) and now vested in him (b) and of all other enabling powers:—

- 1. For the purpose of connecting the Motorway with other highways, so as to effect a junction at the place stated in the Schedule hereto, the Secretary of State is authorised to provide along the routes described in the said Schedule special roads for the use of traffic of Classes I and II of the classes of traffic set out in Schedule 4 to the Highways Act 1959, as amended (c).
- 2. The centre lines of the special roads are indicated by heavy black lines lettered A to D on the deposited plan.
- 3. The special roads shall become trunk roads on the date when this Scheme comes into operation.

## 4. In this Scheme:—

"the Motorway" means the special road to be provided in pursuance of the M25 Motorway (Runnymede Bridge to Yeoveney) Scheme 1977(d);

"the deposited plan" means the plan folio numbered CSE 425/8A/26/07 marked "The M25 Motorway (Staines Interchange Connecting Roads) Scheme 1977", containing one map, signed by authority of the Secretary of State and deposited at the Department of Transport, St. Christopher House, Southwark Street, London, SEI 0TE;

"the special roads" means all the special roads which the Secretary of State is authorised by this Scheme to provide.

5. This Scheme shall come into operation on 8th December 1977 and may be cited as the M25 Motorway (Staines Interchange Connecting Roads) Scheme 1977.

### THE ROUTES OF THE SPECIAL ROADS
