The Patents Act 1977 (Commencement No. 1) Order 1977

Made - - - - 15th December 1977

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 132(5) of the Patents Act 1977, hereby orders as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Patents Act 1977 (Commencement No. 1) Order 1977.
- **2.** Sections 84, 85, 114 and 130 of the Patents Act 1977 shall come into operation on 31st December 1977.
- **3.** Section 132(7) of the Patents Act 1977 shall, for the purpose of repealing section 88 of the Patents Act 1949, come into operation on 31st December 1977.
