WATER, ENGLAND AND WALES

The Southern Water Authority (Winchester) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1977

Made - - - - 15th December 1977

Coming into Operation 1st February 1978

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by the proviso to section 19(6) of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the Southern Water Authority (Winchester) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st February 1978.

2. The byelaws made on 3rd February 1965 by the mayor, aldermen and citizens of the City of Winchester acting by the Council, under section 17 of the Water Act 1945, which byelaws would, by virtue of the Southern Water Authority (Winchester) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1976(c), remain in force until 2nd February 1978, shall remain in force until 2nd February 1979.
