**The Northumbrian Water Authority (Tynemouth) (Extension of
Operation of Byelaws) Order 1977**

Made - - - - 15th December 1977

Coming into Operation 1st January 1978

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by the proviso to section 19(6) of the Water Act 1945 (a) and now vested in him (b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the Northumbrian Water Authority (Tynemouth) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1978.

2. The byelaws made on 13th January 1964 by the mayor, aldermen and burgesses of the county borough of Tynemouth acting by the council of that county borough under section 17 of the Water Act 1945, which byelaws would, by virtue of the Northumbrian Water Authority (Tynemouth) (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1976 (c), remain in force until 12th January 1978, shall remain in force until 12th January 1979.
