**The Fishing Vessels (Acquisition and Improvement)
 (Grants) (Variation) Scheme 1977**

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretary of State for Scotland and the Secretary of State for Wales (being the Secretaries of State concerned with the sea fishing industry in Scotland and Wales respectively) in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 44, 45 and 57 of the Sea Fish Industry Act 1970^(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, with the approval of the Treasury and after consultation with the White Fish Authority and the Herring Industry Board, hereby make the following scheme:—

Citation, extent and commencement

1. This scheme, which may be cited as the Fishing Vessels (Acquisition and Improvement) (Grants) (Variation) Scheme 1977, shall apply to Great Britain and shall come into operation on the day after it has been approved by resolution of each House of Parliament.

Interpretation

2.—(1) In this scheme “the Principal Scheme” means the Fishing Vessels (Acquisition and Improvement) (Grants) Scheme 1976^(b) as varied^(c);

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889^(d) shall apply for the interpretation of this scheme as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Variation of Principal Scheme

3. In paragraph 8(1)^(a) of the Principal Scheme for the words “1st January 1978” there shall be substituted the words “1st January 1979”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Scheme.)

This Scheme further varies the Fishing Vessels (Acquisition and Improvement) (Grants) Scheme 1976 which enables grants to be made by the White Fish Authority and the Herring Industry Board towards expenditure incurred in the acquisition or improvement of vessels engaged or to be engaged in catching or processing white fish or herring.

No grant may be paid under that Scheme (as varied) unless the relevant application is approved before 1st January 1978; this Scheme substitutes 1st January 1979 for that date.

This Scheme was approved by a resolution of the House of Commons on 16th December 1977 and a resolution of the House of Lords on 12th December 1977 and comes into operation on 17th December 1977.
