1977 No. 672 (S. 57)**SHERIFF COURT, SCOTLAND**
The Sheriff Court Districts (Amendment) Order 1977*Made - - - - - 4th April 1977**Coming into Operation 29th April 1977*

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 3 of the Sheriff Courts (Scotland) Act 1971(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Sheriff Court Districts (Amendment) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 29th April 1977.

2.—(1) In this order any reference to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended or extended by or under any other enactment.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. Sheriff courts shall at 29th April 1977 cease to be held at Nairn.

4. The Sheriff Court Districts Reorganisation Order 1975(c) as amended(d) is hereby amended—

(a) by deleting in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule thereto the words “Nairn”, “The district of Nairn” and “Nairn” respectively; and

(b) by substituting in column 3 of the Schedule thereto for the description of the new sheriff court district of Inverness the words “The district of Badenoch and Strathspey and the districts of Inverness and Nairn.”
