**The Naval Medical Compassionate Fund (Amendment)
Order 1977**

Made - - - - - 11th May 1977

Coming into Operation 12th May 1977

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 11th day of May 1977

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in pursuance of section 1 of the Naval Medical Compassionate Fund Act 1915(a) as amended by the Defence (Transfer of Functions) (No. 1) Order 1964(b) and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1.—(1) This Order shall come into operation on 12th May 1977 and may be cited as the Naval Medical Compassionate Fund (Amendment) Order 1977.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The Order in Council dated 28th July 1915(d), whereby Standing Orders and Regulations for the Constitution and Government of the Naval Medical Compassionate Fund were approved, shall be amended as follows:—
Article 8 of the said Standing Orders and Regulations shall be amended by the insertion after the figures “£1 1s. 0d.” of the words “or such sum as the Trustees may decide”.
