**The Local Government (Allowances to Members)  
(Prescribed Bodies) Regulations 1977**

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 177(1)(f) of the Local Government Act 1972(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:—

*Citation and Commencement*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Local Government (Allowances to Members) (Prescribed Bodies) Regulations 1977 and shall come into operation on 9th June 1977.

*Interpretation*

2. The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of these regulations as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

*Prescribed Body*

3. The following body is hereby prescribed for the purpose of sections 173 to 175 of the Local Government Act 1972 (which provide for the payment of allowances to members of local authorities and other bodies), namely, the Board of Governors of the Museum of London.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

Paragraphs (a) to (e) of section 177(1) of the Local Government Act 1972 set out certain bodies which are empowered to pay allowances to their members as provided in sections 173 to 175. Paragraph (f) of that section enables the Secretary of State to prescribe any body on which any such body as is mentioned in paragraphs (a) to (e) as a body to which sections 173 to 175 shall apply. These regulations prescribe for this purpose the Board of Governors of the Museum of London.
