## AGRICULTURAL GRANTS, GOODS AND SERVICES

**The Agricultural and Horticultural Co-operation Grants  
(Extension of Period) Order 1977**
*Laid before the House of Commons in draft**Made - - - 12th May 1977**Coming into Operation 15th May 1977*

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretary of State for Scotland and the Secretary of State for Wales, acting jointly in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 61(6) and 62 of the Agriculture Act 1967(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), as read with the Transfer of Functions (Wales) Order 1969(b), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, with the approval of the Treasury, hereby make the following order, a draft whereof has been laid before and approved by resolution of the Commons House of Parliament:—

*Citation, commencement and interpretation*

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Agricultural and Horticultural Co-operation Grants (Extension of Period) Order 1977, and shall come into operation on 15th May 1977.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(c) shall apply to the interpretation of this order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

*Extension of Period*

2. The period within which proposals must be submitted to the Central Council for Agricultural and Horticultural Co-operation in respect of which grant is payable under section 61 of the Act (which period would otherwise expire with 14th May 1977) is hereby extended for an additional period of three years beginning with 15th May 1977.
