In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 54(4) of and paragraph 1 of Schedule 3 to the Powers of Criminal Courts Act 1973(a) (as extended by Article 3 of the Combined Probation and After-Care Areas Order 1974(b)) and after the consultation required by that paragraph, I hereby make the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Combined Probation and After-Care Areas Order (Gloucestershire) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 24th May 1977.
- 2. That part of Schedule 2 to the Combined Probation and After-Care Areas 1974, as amended(c), which relates to the Gloucestershire Probation and After-Care Committee shall be amended by omitting the entry in respect of the petty sessions area of Newent.
- 3. The two justices appointed to be members of the Gloucestershire Probation and After-Care Committee by the justices for the petty sessional divisions of Gloucester (County) and Newent before those divisions were combined to form a new division known as the Gloucester County division shall continue to be members of that Committee until the first appointment of a member of that Committee by the justices for the new division takes effect on 6th December 1977.
