**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The Trunk Road (Edgware Road, Barnet and Brent)  
(Restricted Road) Order 1977**

*Made - - - -* 18th May 1977  
*Coming into Operation* 20th May 1977

The Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 72(3) and 73(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967(a) as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968(b), and now vested in him(c), and of all other enabling powers hereby orders and directs as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trunk Road (Edgware Road, Barnet and Brent) (Restricted Road) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 20th May 1977.

2.—(1) In this Order:—

“Edgware Road” means that length of the London-Holyhead trunk road (A5) in the London Boroughs of Barnet and Brent known as Edgware Road;

“Staples Corner roundabout” means the roundabout at the junction of Edgware Road (A5) and West Hendon Broadway (A5) with North Circular Road (A406);

“Edgware Road flyover” means the provision made in Edgware Road for the passage of through traffic in Edgware Road over the Staples Corner roundabout.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(d) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The Edgware Road flyover shall be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 71 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967.
