**WATER, ENGLAND AND WALES**  
**The Bristol Waterworks Company (Extension of**  
**Operation of Byelaws) Order 1977**

*Made* - - - 24th May 1977

*Coming into Operation* 1st June 1977.

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by the proviso to section 19(6) of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him (b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This order may be cited as the Bristol Waterworks Company (Extension of Operation of Byelaws) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 1st June 1977.

2. The byelaws made on 5th June 1967 by the Bristol Waterworks Company under section 17 of the Water Act 1945, which byelaws would, but for this order, cease to have effect on 4th June 1977, shall remain in force until 31st December 1977.
