The Pool Competitions Act 1971 (Continuance) Order 1977

Laid before Parliament in draft

Made - - - - - 2nd June 1977

Coming into Operation 26th July 1977

Whereas a draft of this Order has been approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 8(2) and (3) of the Pool Competitions Act 1971(a), I hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Pool Competitions Act 1971 (Continuance) Order 1977 and shall come into operation on 26th July 1977.

2.—(1) In this Order “the Act” means the Pool Competitions Act 1971 as for the time being amended by or under any enactment.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The period specified in section 8(1) of the Act (which relates to the duration of the Act), as extended by the Pool Competitions Act 1971 (Continuance) Order 1976(c), is hereby further extended so as to expire with 26th July 1978.
