**The Safety of Sports Grounds (Designation) (Scotland)
Order 1978**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 1(1) of the Safety of Sports Grounds Act 1975(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after consultation with such persons or bodies of persons as appear to me requisite, I hereby make the following order:—

1.—(1) This order, which extends to Scotland only, may be cited as the Safety of Sports Grounds (Designation) (Scotland) Order 1978 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1979.

(2) The Interpretation Act 1889(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The stadium specified in the Schedule to this order, being a sports stadium which in the opinion of the Secretary of State has accommodation for more than 10,000 spectators, is hereby designated as a stadium requiring a safety certificate under the Safety of Sports Grounds Act 1975.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order designates Cappielow Park, Greenock as a stadium which requires a safety certificate under the Safety of Sports Grounds Act 1975. Other sports stadia in Scotland which require safety certificates are designated under the Safety of Sports Grounds (Designation) (Scotland) Orders 1976 (S.I. 1976/1285) and 1977 (S.I. 1977/1345).
