WATER, ENGLAND AND WALES

The Welsh Water Authority (Pennar and Buttermilk Estates)
Order 1978

Made - - - - 8th August 1978

Coming into Operation 17th August 1978

The Secretary of State for Wales, in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby orders as follows:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Welsh Water Authority (Pennar Citation and Buttermilk Estates) Order 1978 and shall come into operation on 17th and August 1978. Commence-
ment.

(2) This order shall be included among the enactments which may be cited together as the Welsh Water Authority Orders 1976 to 1978.

2. In this order, unless the context otherwise requires—

Interpreta-
tion.

“the Authority” means the Welsh Water Authority;

“the deposited plan No. 1” and “the deposited plan No. 2” means the plans prepared in duplicate signed by the authority of the Secretary of State and marked “Plan No. 1 (or No. 2 as the case may be) referred to in the Welsh Water Authority (Pennar and Buttermilk Estates) Order 1978” one duplicate of each of which is deposited and available for inspection at the offices of the Authority and the other at the Welsh Office, Cathays Park, Cardiff;

“the Third Schedule” means the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945;

“the undertaking” means the undertaking of the Authority as from time to time authorised by any enactment.

3.—(1) The Authority may acquire by agreement and thereafter continue and maintain— Power to
acquire
water-
works.

(a) the pumps shown coloured green on the deposited plan No. 1; and

(b) the mains, pipes and apparatus the approximate lengths and positions of which are shown by blue lines on the deposited plan No. 1 and the deposited plan No. 2.

(2) The said pumps, mains, pipes and apparatus when acquired by the Authority shall for all purposes form part of the undertaking and for the purposes of the Third Schedule as applied to the undertaking the said mains, pipes and apparatus shall be deemed to have been laid or constructed by the Authority for the purpose of giving a general supply of water.

Incorporation of section 94 of Third Schedule.

4. For the purposes of this order section 94 of the Third Schedule (which requires copies of the Special Act to be kept by undertakers in their office and to be deposited with certain officers) shall apply to the undertaking and is hereby incorporated with this order.
